How we obtain your personal data, information provided by you.

We will take reasonable security measures to protect your personal data. We will keep information about you confidential and we will keep it for an appropriate period of time in order to manage and administer your membership.

The General Data Protection Regulation grants you the right to access particular personal data that we hold about you.

You have the right to ask us to delete any personal data concerning you without undue delay.

Accuracy of information

In order to provide the service to our members, we need to keep accurate personal data about you and we need you to inform us of any changes to your contact details, such as name or address changes when they occur.
